<p>Family Learning Centers This a joint partnership between Harlingen CISD, the Harlingen Housing Authority, and Cameron County Housing Authority. These centers are located at five of Harlingen’s Housing Developments including Bonita Park, Le Monye Gardens, Los Vecinos, Sun Set Terrace and Casa Grande. The goal of these centers is to provide students that live on the premises and in nearby residences with tutoring opportunities.
